# Social Media apps

Have taken steps to reduce misinformation







Recognising fake media Using database of items fact-

checkers or news sites have identified as fake.



Alerting users The UI either obscures the media in some way, or adds an alert next to it.



### Providing reliable information

Links to reliable resources or fact-checks about the issue.





Messaging App WhatsApp



Misinformation circulates widely on WhatsApp, and typically in the form of unsourced, anonymous rumours that do not link to any external sources.

#### "Forwarded" marker

Frequently forwarded and very frequently forwarded messages are marked with single and double arrow respectively.



#### **Forwarding limit**

Reducing how many people or groups a single message can be forwarded to from unlimited to 10 to 5 and recently to 1.



#### Information campaigns

Newspaper advertisments, street plays, radio shows to tell people about the dangers of sharing fake news.



### **User Driven Fact-checking**

Users will correct other users when they post something wrong.







The clue is in the rebuttal itself: it







### Why people rarely correct others

#### Stressful

There is a chance of offending someone, especially an older person.

#### **Takes effort**

Fact-checking someone takes a lot more effort than forwarding a message.

#### Low ability

People with lower technological or media literacy may find the process difficult.

#### Volume

There are just so many messages on WhatsApp each day that a bulk of them are ignored. Why people rarely correct others ...and it might not work even when they do

#### Trust in known people

WhatsApp conversations are usually between known people, and there is trust in social circles.

#### Personal beliefs

People may outright reject facts when they do not align with their worldview or personal beliefs.

#### Seen an an attack

People do not like being corrected, especially in social groups. It may be seen as disrespectful to correct an elder.

#### **Repetition enforces belief**

Repetition of false facts can cause them to be remembered as true, and the source may be forgotten. Why people rarely correct others ...and it might not work even when they do ...but it's still worth doing.

#### Works sometimes

Someone who is deeply convinced about a subject may not listen to a factcheck, an unsure person may.

#### Bystanders may doubt

Groups can have up to 256 members, people other than the poster may benefit from the correction.

#### **Unsourced corrections**

According to Badrinathan et al. (2020), even unsourced corrections from other users can cause people to reconsider beliefs.

#### Identity of corrector

If the correction is coming from a known, trusted person, people are more likely to believe the fact-check.

#### Reliance on grants for funding

Fact-checking organisations are often resource constrained and didn't have budgets for developing software.



### No way to automate the process (API restrictions)

The websites typically don't maintain a searchable database of claims, and WhatsApp is very selective with bot API access.



### Responding to user tips is not a priority

High volume of messages being managed through regular WhatsApp interface, hard to keep track.

#### Journalistic fact-checking is labor intensive

There is too much misinformation to address all of it. Fact-checkers are fighting a losing battle.



### Local language content requires native speakers

Important to have fact-checkers that speak languages other than English, Hindi.



#### Content can be text, image, images of text, audio, video

Different modalities pose different challenges—e.g. videos often are real, but titled incorrectly.

## Why would crowdsourcing work?





#### + Stackoverflow

- Q&A site for professional, enthusiast programmers.
- Gamification: Badges, reputation points, slowly unlocking features.
- As of 2011, 92% of the questions were answered, in a median time of 11 minutes.



### WIKIPEDIA The Free Encyclopedia

#### + Wikipedia

- 5th most popular website in the world.
- 40 million+ articles in 309 languages.
- Sometimes has edit wars and errors.
- Open nature generally leads to self-correction.
- 77% of articles are written by 1% of editors.
- Complicated edit process.

### User Evaluation

#### 10 users

#### Self-explanatory website

The website was largely self-explanatory, and people understood how it worked within a few minutes.

#### Successful task completion

All users were able to successfully complete tasks like submitting a post, adding and editing a factcheck, adding a summary, voting and commenting.

#### People found it useful

A number of users commented that they would find something like this useful, and asked if they could share it with family members.

#### Too easy to edit

A number of people made changes to the content on the page to see what would happen, and realised they couldn't change things back to how they were. An undo option was required.

#### Only 1 person returned to post

Only one person submitted something to the website after the user testing session, suggesting that motivations to use the tool are not very high.

### **Expert Evaluation**

#### Tattle, Civic Tech organisation working in fake news.

#### Promising idea

There is interest in working on fake news, but it is currently diffused. It would be good to have a platform to organise around.

#### Try to build a community before building technology

A suggestion that I could try building a community of volunteer fact-checkers on an existing platform like Reddit, and try to funnel users from there.

#### Potential for misuse

An archive of misinformation can be misused by people who want to share misinformation!

As a tool for fake news researchers

Access to fake news content on WhatsApp is an issue I had stumbled upon earlier, but not focused on. There could be a researcher mode which offers an overview of fake news stories, tracks their spread over time, etc.

Would like to take this forward!
 I will be working with Tattle over the next few months to refine the design and publicly release it.
